

RICHMOND, VA. (AP)-"NO AMOUNT OF PRESS AGENCY OR DARKENED ROOMS WILL HIDE THE CRACKS IN THE SORRY RECORD OF THE JOHNSON ADMINISTRATION," REP. ROBERT DOLE, R-KAN., SAID TONIGHT.

DOLE, IN A SPEECH FOR THE 3RD DISTRICT REPUBLICAN ASSOCIATION, SAID IT HAS BEEN STATED THAT THE "ENVIRONMENT IN WASHINGTON 'BEST RESEMBLES A CCC CAMP'--CONFUSION, CONSTERNATION AND CONNIVING."

"THE PRESIDENT HIMSELF RECENTLY TAGGED HIS ADMINISTRATION AS THE 'BETTER DEAL,' BUT I PREDICT THAT MANY WILL SOON REFER TO IT AS THE 'DOUBLE DEAL' AND FINALLY THE 'ORDEAL,'" DOLE SAID.
