**DOLE TALKS ABOUT RECENT SUPREME COURT'S DECISION ON STATE REAPPORTIONMENT
LAST THURSDAY NOON IN WAKBENEY AT LUNCHEON**

CONGRESSMAN BOB DOLE ADDRESSED STUDENTS AND FACULTY MEMBERS OF TREGO COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL LAST THURSDAY MORNING AT A SPECIAL ASSEMBLY MEETING. HIS TALK WAS FOLLOWED BY A QUESTION AND ANSWER PERIOD. HE GAVE THE STUDENTS A NON-POLITICAL EXPLANATION OF THE REAPPORTIONMENT DECISION BY THE SUPREME COURT LAST JUNE 15.

Dole SPOKE AT A NOON LUNCHEON TO ABOUT SEVENTY PERSONS. HE BLASTED THE SUPREME COURT DECISION AS AN INITIAL STEP IN BREAKING DOWN OUR FORM OF GOVERNMENT. "THE ONE-MAN-ONE-VOTE RULING COULD CUT OUR VOTE IN WESTERN KANSAS IN HALF" HE SAID.

UNDER THE RECENT RULING, DOLE EXPLAINED BOTH HOUSES OF THE STATE LEGISLATURE WOULD BE REAPPORTIONED ON A POPULATION BASIS ONLY, AND APPROXIMATELY 17,400 PEOPLE WOULD REPRESENT ONE VOTE. IN THE WESTERN PART OF KANSAS IT WILL TAKE SIX COUNTIES TO MAKE ONE VOTE, UNDER THE NEW RULING. "THIS IS A STATE POLITICAL MATTER WHICH SHOULD BE HANDLED ON THE STATE LEVEL", DOLE ADDED.

AFTER THE JUNE 15, SUPREME COURT DECISION, DOLE INTRODUCED A RESOLUTION IN THE HOUSE FOR AN AMENDMENT OF THE CONSTITUTION WHICH WOULD RESERVE STATE LEGISLATURE APPOINTMENT POWER TO THE STATE. CONGRESS ADJOURNED WITHOUT TAKING ANY ACTION ON IT.

CONGRESSMAN DOLE GIVES VERBAL SUPPORT OF TO BARRY GOLDWATER. DOLE SAYS "HONESTY SHOULD NOT DISQUALIFY FROM BECOMING PRESIDENT" *of the United States.*

AFTER THE LUNCHEON, CONGRESSMAN DOLE ACCOMPANIED BY MRS. CLAYTON HILYARD AND ELISHA GARRATT VISITED A FEW PLACES OF BUSINESS IN WAKBENEY BEFORE TAKING OFF BY PLANE FOR OTHER COMMITMENTS.

CONGRESSMAN DOLE IS SEEKING RE-ELECTION AS FIRST DISTRICT CONGRESSMAN ON THE REPUBLICAN TICKET. DOLE'S VOTING RECORD IS 100 PERCENT AGAINST THE A. D. A. (AMERICANS FOR DEMOCRATIC ACTION) WHICH IS A SO-CALLED LEFT WING LIBERAL ORGANIZATION WHICH HUBERT HUMPHREY WAS VICE-PRESIDENT OF, AT THE TIME OF HIS NOMINATION FOR VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.
