Hutchinson - The Eisenhower and Nixon visits to the First District will highlight Congressman Bob Dole's itinerary this week. Sunday, Dole traveled to Pratt and Liberal to participate in planning meetings for the rallies.

Monday, Dole covered Rice County with stops in Bushton, Chase, Lyons and Sterling.

Tuesday's itinery includes an early morning stop in Colby, a coffee in Oakley, and a stop in Winona before traveling to Sharon Springs for lunch. There will be afternoon stops in St. Francis and Bird City before the evening meeting at Atwood.

Wednesday's highlight is the visit of Richard Nixon to Pratt.

Dole will return to the campaign trail Thrusday with breakfast in Oberlin, coffee in Norton and a Smith County Republican Women's Tea in the afternoon in Smith Center. There will be an evening meeting in Phillipsburg.

Friday, Dole will be in Ellsworth County with stops in Wilson and Ellsworth. That evening, he will travel to Salina for a meeting.

Former President Eisenhower will be in Liberal Saturday morning and that evening Dole will go to St. John for a Stafford County rally.
