Congressman Bob Dole announced today he has been informed by the Federal Aviation Agency that the Liberal airport will be provided new an Airport Information Desk on January 1, 1965.

Dole explained the Airport Information Desk is a new type of terminal service facility which will provide fastline service to a parent flight service station; service "A" weather teletype! and current flight planning data.
