Washington, D. C. --- July 24, 1965

Ralph R. Roberts, Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, has released the official attendance and voting records of the House of Representatives for the first one hundred seventy nine Roll Calls of the First Session of the Eighty-Ninth Congress covering the period from January 4, 1965, to July 6, 1965. The hundred seventy nine Roll Calls include both quorum calls and Roll Call votes.

The Clerk's records show that Congressman Bob Dole has missed only one of ninety-two quorum calls and only two of eighty-seven Roll Call votes. Percentage-wise Congressman Dole has been present and voting over ninety-eight per cent of the time. The three "misses" all occurred on May 20, while Congressman Dole was in Kansas to deliver the Phillipsburg High School Commencement Address.
