Hutchinson-Rep. Bob Dole announced today he is accepting applications from young men interested in entering service academies for the 1966 classes.

The First District Congressman stated he has two vacancies at the United States Naval Academy— one each at the Air Force and Military academies, and ten at the Merchant Marine Academy. Coast Guard Academy applicants must apply directly to The Commandant, U. S. Coast Guard, Washington, D. C., before December 1, 1965.

Academy applicants must be single, between the ages of 17 and 22, as of July 1, 1966, and must reside in the area covered by the First Congressional District.

Dole stated that applicants are required to take a Civil Service Examination early in November and must appear before the Academy Screening Board at its meeting late in December at Fort Hays State College.

"Inquiries should be mailed to my District office, 211 Federal Building, Hutchinson," Dole said, "and applications cannot be accepted after October 1, 1965".
