Congressman Bob Dole has announced a tour of several Kansas colleges and universities. He will begin by visiting the University of Kansas campus, Monday, November 1. As an alumnus of Washburn University he will visit there The Tuesday morning, going on to Kansas State University that afternoon. Wednesday will be spent on the Fort Hays Kansas State College campus and Thursday will wind up the tour with a visit to Kansas Wesleyan University and Marymount College in Salina.

At each of the announced stops, Dole will visit with faculty and student leaders, speak to political science and government classes and meet with students from the First Congressional District. Special evening meetings have been scheduled for Kansas State University, Fort Hays Kansas State College and Kansas Wesleyan University.

"Meeting young people is always a challenge," Dole said in announcing the tour, "and I am anxious to hear their comments on anything from Appalachia to Viet-Nam."

Dole will begin a tour of the District on November 10 before leaving for Rome on November 20.
