Ralph R. Roberts, Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, has released the official Attendance and Voting records of House members for the 1st Session of the 89th Congress which commenced January 3, and ended Saturday, October 23, 1965. It was a record-breaking session insofar as roll calls were concerned, as there were 182 quorum calls and 201 roll call votes. Members were asked to respond when their names were called a total of 383 times.

The official records indicate that Congressman Dole missed 2 of the 182 quorum calls and 3 of the 201 roll calls. Percentagewise, he was present and voting nearly 99 percent of the time.

Dole commented: "Constituents rightfully expect their Congressman to be on the job unless illness or absences on "official" business prevents it. Many may not agree with a particular vote, but most people appreciate the fact their Congressman was present and voting on important issues."
