FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Congressman Bob Dole (R-Kans) today indicated that students differ with their parents on many issues covered in his First District "Opinion Poll".

Dole stated that 205 high school students in Liberal and 99 high school students in Godland have participated in the poll. While on some questions the student results are about the same as those received from Seward and Sherman Counties' adult participants, there are substantial differences on some issues.
