Ralph R. Roberts, Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, has released the official Attendance and Voting records of House members for the second session of the 89th Congress which commenced January 10, 1966. The Voting and Attendance records are recorded through June 9, 1966. There were 72 roll call votes.

The official records indicate that Congressman Dole missed 1 of the 72 roll call votes. Percentagewise, he was present and voting nearly 99 percent of the time.

"Constituents rightfully expect their Congressman Dole commented: to be on the job unless illness or absences on "official" business prevent Many may not agree with a particular vote, but most people appreciate the fact their Congressman was present and voting on important issues."
