WASHINGTON- Rep. Bob Dole (R.Kans.) announced he is accepting applications from young men interested in entering service academies for the 1967 classes.

Naval Academy, Annapolis, two to the United States Military Academy, West Point, and ten to the Merchant Marine Academy, Kings Point.
