Ralph R. Roberts, Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, has released, for the second time this year, the official Attendance and Voting records of House members for the second session of the 89th Congress which commenced January 10, 1966. The Voting and Attendance records are recorded through August 11, 1966. Since January 10, there have been 95 roll call votes.

The official records indicate that Congressman Dole missed only 1 of the 95 roll calls. Percentage wise, he has been present and voting nearly 99% of the time.

Dole commented: "Constituents rightfully expect their Congressman to be on the job unless illness or absences on "official" business prevent it. Many may not agree with a particular vote, but more people appreciate the fact their Congressman was present and voting on important issues."

The average attendance record on roll call votes for all Congressmen, according to the "Congressional Quarterly Magazine", is approximately 87%.
