Ralph R. Roberts, Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, has released the final official Attendance and Voting records of House members for the second session of the 89th Congress which commenced January 10, 1966. The Voting and Attendance records are recorded through October 22, 1966, the final day of the session. Since January 10, there have been 193 Roll Call votes.

The official records indicate that Congressman Dole missed only 1 of the 193 Roll Call votes. Percentage wise, he has been present and voting nearly 99.4% of the time.

Dole commented: "This has been a long, hard session, and there is an outside chance that Congress may reconvene after the elections. I recognize that a Member should not be judged only on attendance, but I firmly believe that the great majority of people in my District appreciate the fact their Congressman was present and voting on every important issue."

Congressman Dole is presently in the District and plans to visit each of the 52 counties in his District between now and November 8.
