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WASHINGTON, D. C. May 2BOB DOLE Cong. Bob Dole (R-Kas.) stated today he has been notified by the US Office of Education that the division of education and psychology at Fort Hays Kansas State College, Hays, Kas., has been awarded \$18,000 for five traineeships for the 190,-68 school year. This will provide special training in teacher education for the mentally retarded. Director of the program is Dr. John D. King.
