Congressman Bob Dole (R-Kansas) member of the House Committee on Agriculture, will make two speeches in Chicago this week. On Thursday he will address the First International Agribusiness Conference sponsored by the Chicago Board of Trade. His topic will be "Impact of World Food Needs and Agricultural Exports on the American Farmer".

Others speaking at the Conference include Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey, C. S. Krishna Moorthi, Vice President of the Asian Development Bank, and Dr. Samuel A. On Friday morning Dole will address the 26th Annual Meeting of the National Independent Meat Packers Association. His topic at this meeting will be "Legislative Issues of Vital Importance to Meat Packers". Congressman Graham Purcell of Texas, who is the Chairman of the Livestock and Grains Subcommittee, will also speak to the meat packers.
