WASHINGTON, D.C., Nov. 22 -- Thirty-one young men from western Kansas are candidates for appointment by Congressman Bob Dole (R-Kans.) to the U. S. Army, Navy and Air Force Academies.

The young men, all residents of Dole's Congressional District, will be interviewed Saturday, November 25 by a screening board selected by Dole. Board members will begin interviews at 8:30 a.m. in the Sheridan Coliseum of Fort Hays State College in Hays.

Dr. Richard E. Burnett, assistant to the president of the Fort Hays College, will serve as chairman of the board. Advisors with a military background will assist.

Dole said the board will make recommendations for appointments to the three academies. He said he will consider board recommendations and announce final appointments in early January.

"It is apparent already that the board has a tough assignment," the Congressman said. "Our applicants have amassed unusually impressive school, activity and community records."
