TEXT OF RADIO TAPE

SALINA SENIOR CITIZENS CONFERENCE

"This is Congressman Bob Dole with a special report about the Senior Citizens Conference to be held in Salina, Kansas, on December 9.

Recent figures indicate that one out of 9 citizens is age 65 and over and without question, those in this category are confronted with personal, social and economic problems.

In an effort to focus attention upon the needs and upon the programs -- state and federal -- affecting our senior citizens, I am sponsoring a series of Senior Citizens Conferences in western Kansas. The first such conference will be held at 1:30 p.m., Saturday, December 9 in the Salina high school auditorium. Everyone in the Salina area -- retired, about to retire, or those just interested in senior citizens -- is invited.
