WASHINGTON, D.C., Jan. 9, 1968 -- The Washington staff of Congressman Bob Dole today said a public hearing on the proposed discontinuance of the Santa Fe Chief (19 and 20) and the Grand Canyon (23 and 24) trains has been tentatively scheduled.

A staff spokesman said the Interstate Commerce Commission notified Dole's office the hearing will be February 23 in Dodge City, if a meeting place is obtained.
