WASHINGTON, D.C., March 8 -- Congressman Bob Dole (R-Kans.) today announced the appointment of a regional advisory council to help program the March 22 Senior Citizens Conference in Hays.

Dole said the council, representing 17 western Kansas counties, will help plan and host the conference.

"By working closely with these men and women," Dole said, "we will be better able to present a program which responds efficiently and effectively to the questions many senior citizens share."

The conference, designed to review and explain state and federal programs affecting persons over age 60, will begin at 1:30 p.m. in the Hays National Guard Armory.

Representatives of the State Departments of Labor and Social Welfare, the Kansas Veterans' Commission and regional offices of the Social Security Administration, Small Business Administration and Veterans' Administration will join Dole in the afternoon program.

The Hays program is the second in a series of conferences for First District residents. The first was held in December in Salina.
