Congressman Bob Dole today named Wayne Angell of Ottawa, Kansas, as the 3rd Congressional District Dole for Senate Chairman and Mrs. L. D. (Jan) Meyers of Overland Park as the District Co-Chairman. Angell, a former state legislator and a candidate for Congress in 1966, is now a professor of economics at Ottawa University. Mrs. Meyers is a member of the Overland Park City Council.

Dole, a Republican candidate for the U. S. Senate, said Angell and Mrs. Meyers will coordinate his campaign activities in Anderson, Douglas, Franklin, Johnson and Miami Counties.
