WASHINGTON, D.C. Jan. 30 -- U.S. Senator Bob Dole tonight said that ³⁴¹
"Credit for progress toward peace in Vietnam goes largely to the
American people.

"Our fighting men denied Hanoi a victory on the battlefield,
now the enemy cannot look for victory through American dissension at
home, for the American people have overwhelmingly demonstrated their
desire for a just peace.

"The Nixon plan for increasing Vietnamization of the war
would never have been possible without such a strong show of
support," Dole said.
