WASHINGTON, D.C., Sept. 30, 1970 -- Senator Bob Dole today predicted that House and Senate conferees would agree on a farm bill yet this week. Dole said he had been in contact with some of the conferees, who were hopeful that the differences between the House and Senate bills could be resolved and that final action could be taken by the Congress in the next few days.

Dole also indicated that he felt the conferees version would meet with the approval of most farmers.
