WASHINGTON, D.C., FEB. 3, 1971 -- U. S. Senator Bob Dole today announced the names of 60 Kansas high school seniors he has nominated for appointment to the U. S. Air Force, Merchant Marine, and Naval Academies for classes beginning mid-summer 1971.

Dole said the young men would be chosen on a strictly competitive basis for the five academy vacancies available to him this year -- three Air Force and two Navy. Final appointments will be made by the academies.

Included in the list of 60 are 10 youths nominated for appointment to fill four vacancies allotted to Kansas at the Merchant Marine Academy. They will compete with young men nominated by the other members of the Kansas delegation. Senator Dole has no U. S. Military Academy (West Point) vacancies this year.

Dole said, "The best-qualified candidates will be selected on the basis of tests stressing academic ability and leadership qualities. Kansas has a great tradition in military leadership exemplified by the late General Eisenhower and I am certain that the Academy classes beginning in '71 will have outstanding young Kansans in their ranks."
