Senator Bob Dole (R-Kans) reconfirmed this morning that five C-130 transport planes from Forbes Air Force Base have been made available to provide the necessary emergency assistance to livestock owners in five storm-struck counties of western Kansas.

"This action", Dole stated, "is the culmination of daylong efforts of my office and Congressman Keith Sebelius". Senator—
Dole, Congressman Sebelius, and six staff members worked around
the Ck past midnight in coordinating efforts with the Federal
agencies involved. Dole personally contacted Secretary of the
Army Stanley Resor; Director of the Office of Emergency Prepared—
ness, General Abe Lincoln; Secretary to the General Staff, General
Warren Bennett; and numerous other high-ranking officials in the
military and the Office of Emergency Preparedness.

Dole was able to reach Governor Robert Docking, who was attending a White House function, late last night so that the official request, as required by law, could be made by the Governor.

Dole added, "We are now advised the C-130's will be launched this afternoon, and our office is coordinating in setting up the areas where the hay is to be dropped".
