WASHINGTON, D.C., March 24 --- The Rural Tel Bank bill passed the House today by a vote of 269-127 to become the Dole-Poage Act.

The House passed measure was an amended version of Senate
Bill 70, which was introduced by U.S. Sen. Bob Dole (R-Kans.)
and was passed earlier by the Senate. Congressman Bob Poage,
chairman of the House Agriculture Committee, sponsored amendments
to the Dole-Poage Act that will be sent to a Joint Conference
Committee, where conferees will work out the difference in the
House and Senate versions.
