U.S. Senators James B. Pearson and Bob Dole announced today two contract grants from the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

(1) The Olathe Urban Renewal Agency has been granted today \$134,112 to increase relocation payments needed by a legislative change in amount of small business displacement payments, replacement housing and relocation payments.

Funds previously obligated for the Olathe Urban Renewal Project are \$3,126,365 for a total of \$3,260,477.

(2) The Atchison Urban Renewal Agency has been granted today \$130,220 to increase relocation payments needed by the federal Uniform Relocation and Land Acquisition Act of 1971.

Funds previously obligated for the Urban Renewal Project are \$2,161,756, for a total of \$2,291,981.
