WASHINGTON, D.C., June 8, 1971--U. S. Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced grants totaling \$188,834 to Kansas from the Office of Economic Opportunity.

Two of the grants go to Sek-Cap Inc. of Girard, serving Allen, Bourbon, Lynn, Crawford, Cherokee, Labette and Montgomery counties; a 12 month grant for \$69,000 to augment senior opportunities and services, and a 6 month grant for \$45,000 to provide family planning and emergency food and medical services.

A third grant, for \$74,834 was awarded to the Kansas

State Economic Opportunity Office in Topeka to provide statewide general technical assistance to communities for 13

months.
