WASHINGTON, D.C., JUNE 16, 1971 -- U. S. Senators James Pearson and Bob Dole today announced that Topeka has been selected as one of two locations for the establishment of a Reading Clinic Visitor Service. The Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, through the National Center for Educational Research and Development, has provided \$60,000 for this purpose.

The Clinic will be open to visitors who wish to examine the program in operation, and limited technical assistance will be available to those who wish to implement similar programs in their own areas.
