WASHINGTON, D.C., August 2, 1971 ----U.S. Sen. Bob Dole (R-Kans.) learned today that the reported case of encephalomyelitis in Cowley County, Kansas, is definitely not of the Venezuelan type that has killed more than 800 horses in Texas.

Dole said that a U.S. Department of Agriculture official informed him today that preliminary laboratory tests taken by the USDA indicated that the Kansas case is of the western type of the vyrus, but further tests will to taken to confirm whether it is of the western or eatern type.

Dole explained that both western and eastern types of the disease are more common than the Venezuelan type and is fairly well controlled by innoculation.
