WASHINGTON, D.C., Sept. 15, 1971 --- U.S. Sen. Bob Dole
(R-Kans.) learned today that two Kansans have been designated
for Presidential appointments.

Dole was informed by the White House this morning that
Homer A. Patton of Leawood will be named to the Air Quality
Advisory Board; and David J. McKay of LaCrosse will be named
to the Rural Telephone Bank Board.

The announcement from the White House will be made by the
White House at noon (EST) today.

Patton is the International Secretary-Treasurer of the
International Brotherhood of Boilermakers, Iron ship builders,
Blacksmiths, Forgerers and Helpers.

McKay is the manager of the Goldern Belt Telephone
Association, Inc.
