WASHINGTON, D.C., OCT. 6, 1971 -- U.S. Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today announced toat Topeka will receive \$327,750 in grants from the Invironmental Protection Agency.

\$195,520 for the construction of a new activated sludge waste treatment plant and \$132,230 for the construction of the Furnam Road interceptor sewer and lift station. Both of these projects are locate north of Topeka.

The total estimated cost at completion of the sludge waste treatment plant is \$729,000 and the interceptor sewer and lift station is \$408,000.
