WASHINGTON, D.C., Jan. 27, 1972 ---- Spanish speaking taxpayers in Kansas may now have an easier time filing their federal income tax returns, U.S. Sen. Bob Dole (R-Kans.) said today in announcing a new publication by the Internal Revenue Service.

Dole said his office is making available a publication designed to assist the Spanish speaking taxpayer in filing tax returns.
