WASHINGTON, D.C., March 24, 1972 ----- U.S. Senators James B. Pearson and Bob Dole announced today a grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development in the amount of \$41,490 for the Neighborhood Development Program in Leavenworth, Kansas. The amount previously obligated by HUD for the program was \$954,960, bringing the total today to \$995,450.

The Kansas Senators said the grant is solely for increased relocation payments as a result of the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970. Project activities include central business district rehabilitation and clearance to provide low and moderate income housing.

The grant project is under the direction of Alfred S. Moore, Executive Director, Urban Renewal Agency of Leavenworth.
