CESSNA TO HIRE, TRAIN, 175 IN INDUSTRY-GOVT PROGRAM

Cessna Aircraft Co., at Wichita, will hire and train 175 disadvantaged workers under the industry-Government Job Opportunities in the Business Sector (JOBS) program, U.S. Senators James B. Pearson and Bob Dole and Congressman Garner Shriver, announced today.

The Kansas Congressman said, the Cessna contract is one of 11 Manpower Administration projects recently approved in Kansas, to provide jobs training, or work experience to 1,031 persons, with \$598 942 in Federal Funds.

Reimbursement to Cessna could reach \$415,925 over the 14-month term of the contract.

Participants in the program will start at \$2.68 an hour, and earn from \$2.86 to 2.94 after training. The plan was approved by District Lodge 774 of the International Association of Machinists, which represents employees in the plant.
