WASHINGTON, D.C., MAY 5, 1972 -- Senator Bob Dole was elected, May 3, to the board of Rehabilitation International, U.S.A.

Since 1922, this non-governmental organization has been actively involved in all aspects of service for people with all types of disabilities.

Rehabilitation International was formed with the cooperation and support of individuals and national organizations working in the rehabilitation field in the United States. It is dedicated solely and entirely to the improvement of rehabilitation services for disabled persons in the U.S. and throughout the world.

Senator Dole will serve as a member of the board for the next three years.
