WASHINGTON, D.C., MAY 16, 1972 -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson announced today that Lawrence U.S.D. #497 has received a \$52,528.00 grant to fund a program to help cope with the problems of the desegregation of the Lawrence Public Schools.

The HEW grant provides funds for the school board to pay, in whole or in part, the cost of:

1. Giving teachers and other school personnel inservice training in dealing with educational problems resulting from the desegregation process, and
2. Employing specialists to advise on solving the problems created by the desegregation process.
