WASHINGTON, D.C., JUNE 14, 1972 -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson announced today that Topeka Board of Education Unified School District #501 has received a \$268,325 Follow Through grant from the office of education in HEW.

The Kansas Senators explained that this grant provides funds for operating a comprehensive program of early elementary education for disadvantaged children who have participated in a Head Start or similar preschool program.
