WASHINGTON, D.C., JULY 20, 1972 -- Senator Bob Dole today announced the appointment of Glenn Weir as Associate Administrator of the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service.

Dole said, "Glenn Weir has demonstrated his knowledge of the farmer's needs and I am confident he shall continue to represent their interests in the administration of the farm program.

Weir, a native of Kansas, has been owner-operator of a wheat and farm operation at Kiowa, Kansas since his graduation from Kansas State University in 1947.

Subsequently, beginning in 1964, he served as a member of the Kansas Wheat Commission for four years. He also was a member of the Board of Directors of Great Plains Wheat, Inc. promoting the export sale of United States wheat.

In July, 1969, Weir became director of the Grain Division of the Agricultural Stabilization and Conversation Service.
