WASHINGTON, D.C., AUG. 11, 1972 -- Senator Bob Dole today reported that the 1973 Public Works Appropriations conference report gives \$23, 935,000 to the Army Corps of Engineers for planning and construction in Kansas.

Dole, a member of the Public Works Committee, reported Kansas projects to be funded for construction are: Big Hill Lake, \$1,000,000; Clinton Lake, \$8,500,000; Dodge City, \$1,300,000; ElDorado Lake, \$1,500,000; Hays Big Creek, \$200,000; Hillsdale Lake, \$500,000; Kansas City, Kan., Kansas River, \$2,400,000; Lawrence, \$400,000; and Melverne Lake, \$6,900,000.

Planning funds recommended for Kansas are: Cedar Point Lake, \$200,000; Great Bend, \$180,000; Grove Lake, \$225,000; Marion, \$90,000; Onega Lake, \$250,000; Perry Lake Area road improvements, \$100,000; Winfield, \$40,000; and Wolf-Coffee Lake, \$150,000.
