WASHINGTON, D.C., SEPT. 29, 1972 -- Senator Bob Dole today announced the appointment of Darrel A. Dunn, a native of Langdon, Kansas, as Associate Administrator of the Farmers Home Aministration. This is the number two position in the FHA.

Senator Dole said, "Darrel Dunn has two decades of experience in agricultural credit work and now will share responsibility for conduct of a program which will invest more than \$3.2 billion in rural America this year. He is extremely well qualified to meet the tremendous responsibilities of this position."

"As Associate Administrator, he will assist in overseeing a broad spectrum of new programs assigned to FHA by the Rural Development Act of 1972, signed into law by President Nixon on August 30."

Dunn's first assignment with FHA was as Kansas State Director from 1953 to 1957. He served as an Assistant Administrator from 1957 to 1961, and subsequently worked for a decade with the Agency for International Development as an agricultural credit advosor in Ankara, Turkey, and New Delhi, India.
