WASHINGTON, D.C., JAN. 3, 1973 -- Senator Bob Dole today announced that re-certification has been obtained for a \$500,000 water and sewer project for Iola, Kansas.

The re-certification of the project will result in the release of \$236,000 from the Department of Housing and Urban Development, \$170,000 from the Ozark Regional Commission and \$160,000 previously raised by the city of Iola through issuance of revenue bonds.

The funds will be used to provide water and sewer service to Iola and adjacent Allen County, including Iola Junior College, industrial facilities and rural communities, and seven rural water districts.

Dole said, "The re-certification and release of these funds will enable the completion of this vital project and greatly enhance the economic and educational future of the Iola-Allen County area."
