WASHINGTON, D.C., JAN. 8, 1973 -- Senator Bob Dole today announced that authorization for continued operation along with assistance for accelerated financing has been made to SEE-KAN Resource Conservation and Development (RC&D) District.

SEE-KAN RC&D projects are self-help programs which coordinate the efforts of local officials in multi-county areas to utilize various government programs. The programs include efforts to improve local environment, conserve natural resources and stimulate the area's economy. The program is financed by the Department of Agriculture.

Kansas counties in the SEE-KAN District are: Allen, Bourbon, Cherokee, Crawford, Labette, Montgomery, Neosho, Wilson, and Woodson.
