WASHINGTON, D.C., JAN. 12, 1973 -- Senator Bob Dole today announced that \$2,183,700 will go to eight water districts in six Kansas counties.

Dole said that these applications for funds had been approved before the January 9 cut off date for such programs. After checking, the Kansas Semator learned that the eight projects had been approved by the Topeka Farmers Home Administration office and were awaiting payment by the finance center in St. Louis.

FHA grants totaled \$631,200 accompanied by \$1,552,500 in loans to make the \$2,183,700 total.
