WASHINGTON, D.C., JAN. 18, 1973 -- Senator Bob Dole will begin his busy Inaugural weekend today at a luncheon and meeting of the State Republican Chairmen's Advisory Committee. This evening he will attend the Vice President's reception and the Salute to the States.

Senator Dole will preside over the Republican National Committee Friday morning. Dole's resignation as RNC Chairman becomes effective the following Tuesday.

On Friday evening, Senator Dole will attend the Inaugural Committee's Salute to America's Heritage and the Concert at the John F. Kennedy Memorial Center.

On Inaugural Day, Senator Dole will be in the Presidential party for the Swearing-in Ceremony and will join the Presidential party for a luncheon following the oath of office. Senator Dole will then join the Presidential motorcade and proceed to the Inaugural Parade Reviewing Stand.

Saturday evening, Senator Dole will be host for the Inaugural Ball at the Smithsonian Museum of Natural History, this is the ball ~~and~~ Kansans will attend. Senator Dole is also expected to drop by the Inaugural Youth Ball at the Sheraton Park Hotel.

On Sunday morning, Senator Dole will attend the White House Worship Service with the President and Sunday evening he will again be at the White House for a reception for members of the Republican National Committee.
