The contract will provide on reservation training to 40 tribal members of the Iowa tribe of Kansas and Nebraska, the Kicapoo tribe of Kansas, the Potawatomi prairie tribe of Kansas, and the Sac and Fox tribes of Missouri, and the Sac and Fox reservations of Nebraska in building trade and equipment operations.

The contract will be awarded on March 1, 1973.
