WASHINGTON, D.C., MAR. 3, 1973 -- Senator Bob Dole today announced that Reynolds Shultz of Lawrence, former Lt. Governor has been named as consultant in the office of the Regional Assistant to the Secretary of Agriculture for Inter-governmental affairs.

In this capacity Shultz will be doing consultant work throughout the state of Kansas on policy and procedure on the various programs administered by the Department of Agriculture.

Dole said Shultz was selected because of his past work in rural community development as Lt Governor and Chairman of the Kansas Economic Development Commission. Also, Dole said Shultz is familiar with all Federal farm programs as he has farming interests in Douglas and Jefferson Counties. Shultz's broad acquaintance throughout Kansas will be most helpful in his work.

The position that Shultz is being placed in is equivalent to a GS-15 in the Civil Service.
