WASHINGTON, D.C., MAR. 16, 1973 -- Senators Bob Dole and James Pearson today met with Senator Alan Bible (D-Nevada), Chairman of the Senate Subcommittee on Parks and Recreation to discuss the proposed User Fees for recreational areas at Corps of Engineers-administered federal resorvoirs. Also present at the meeting were Major General J.W. Morris of the Corps of Engineers, Senators Bartlett and Bellmon of Oklahoma and representatives of other Senators.

The purpose of the meeting was to further express concern for the effects of the proposed User Fees and to search for possible ways of avoiding unnecessary financial burdens and inconvenience for the people who utilize the public areas and facilities at these lakes.
