WASHINGTON, D.C., MAR. 19, 1973 -- Senator Bob Dole today announced that the Farmers Home Administration will fund several rural rental housing applications submitted by Kansas communities.

The office of Management and Budget has approved a transfer of funds with the FmHA making an additional \$1 million available for rural rental projects.

Three rental projects approved today were; Spring Hill, Burlingame and Hartford. Earlier this month rental projects were approved for Chetopa, Osage, Princeton, Oskaloosa and Erie.

Dole had urged action on these projects despite the January 8, housing moratorium because of the extreme need for housing for the elderly.
