Washington, D.C.--March 22--Grants totaling \$520,309 to continue U.S. Manpower programs in Kansas were announced today by Senators James B. Pearson and Bob Dole.

The Kansas Division of Employment Security was granted an additional \$200,000 to continue the Work Incentive (WIN) program.

Neighborhood Youth Corps (NYC) projects for young people in school were extended for the remainder of the school year with \$183,770 allocated to eight projects for 1,015 students who have part time jobs.

Also announced were two new contracts in the Jobs Opportunities in the Business Sector (JOBS) program which will provide jobs and training in private industry to 31 disadvantaged workers.

Those cities receiving aid under the NYC program are El Dorado, Girard, Horton, Hutchinson, Junction City, Kansas City, Plainville and Topeka.

Those cities receiving aid under Operation Mainstream are Dodge City, Fort Scott, Girard, Hutchinson, Kansas City, Plainville and Winfield.
