TOPEKA, KANSAS, APR. 13, 1973 -- Senator Bob Dole addressed the Kansas State Federation of Federal Employees this evening in Topeka.

Dole praised the civil servants saying, "The vast majority of you do your job well, work long hours performing valuable and often essential functions for the people of this country."

Dole told the members of the federation that they should work even harder to improve the service they provide for the American people.

The Kansas Senator said, "It is proper for us as federal employees, to give some thought to where improvements can be made. You can bet that the same thoughts are probably very much on the minds of many average taxpayers who even now are rushing to put their returns together before midnight Monday."
